Psalms

PSALM 107

- O give thanks unto the LORD, for *he is* good: for his mercy *endureth* for ever.
- 2 Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, whom he hath redeemed from the hand of the enemy;
- 3 And gathered them out of the lands, from the east, and from the west, from the north, and from the south.
- They wandered in the wilderness in a solitary way; they found no city to dwell in.
- Hungry and thirsty, their soul fainted in them.
- Then they cried unto the LORD in their trouble, *and* he delivered them out of their distresses.
- And he led them forth by the right way, that they might go to a city of habitation.
- 8 Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!
- For he satisfieth the longing soul, and filleth the hungry soul with goodness.
- Such as sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, *being* bound in affliction and iron;
- 11 Because they rebelled against the words of God, and contemned the counsel of the most High:
- Therefore he brought down their heart with labour; they fell down, and *there was* none to help.
- 13 Then they cried unto the LORD in their trouble, and he saved them out of their distresses.
- He brought them out of darkness and the shadow of death, and brake their bands in sunder.
- 15 Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!
- For he hath broken the gates of brass, and cut the bars of iron in sunder.
- 17 Fools because of their transgression, and because of their iniquities, are afflicted.
- Their soul abhorreth all manner of meat; and they draw near unto the gates of death.
- Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, *and* he saveth them out of their distresses.
- He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered *them* from their destructions.
- 21 Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!
- **22** And let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare his works with rejoicing.
- 23 They that go down to the sea in ships, that do business in great waters;
- These see the works of the LORD, and his wonders in the deep.
- For he commandeth, and raiseth the stormy wind, which lifteth up the waves thereof.
- They mount up to the heaven, they go down again to the depths: their soul is melted because of trouble.
- 27 They reel to and fro, and stagger like a drunken man, and are at their wits' end.
- Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and he bringeth them out of their distresses.
- 29 He maketh the storm a calm, so that the waves thereof are still.
- Then are they glad because they be guiet; so he bringeth them unto their desired haven.
- 31 Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!
- Let them exalt him also in the congregation of the people, and praise him in the assembly of the elders.
- He turneth rivers into a wilderness, and the watersprings into dry ground;
- **34** A fruitful land into barrenness, for the wickedness of them that dwell therein.
- He turneth the wilderness into a standing water, and dry ground into watersprings.
- And there he maketh the hungry to dwell, that they may prepare a city for habitation;
- And sow the fields, and plant vineyards, which may yield fruits of increase.
- He blesseth them also, so that they are multiplied greatly; and suffereth not their cattle to decrease.
- Again, they are minished and brought low through oppression, affliction, and sorrow.
- He poureth contempt upon princes, and causeth them to wander in the wilderness, where there is no way.
- Yet setteth he the poor on high from affliction, and maketh *him* families like a flock.
- The righteous shall see *it*, and rejoice: and all iniquity shall stop her mouth.
- Whoso *is* wise, and will observe these *things*, even they shall understand the lovingkindness of the LORD.

- **1** O God, my heart is fixed; I will sing and give praise, even with my glory.
- **2** Awake, psaltery and harp: I *myself* will awake early.
- 3 I will praise thee, O LORD, among the people: and I will sing praises unto thee among the nations.
- **4** For thy mercy *is* great above the heavens: and thy truth *reacheth* unto the clouds.
- **5** Be thou exalted, O God, above the heavens: and thy glory above all the earth;
- **6** That thy beloved may be delivered: save with thy right hand, and answer me.
- **7** God hath spoken in his holiness; I will rejoice, I will divide Shechem, and mete out the valley of Succoth.
- 8 Gilead is mine; Manasseh is mine; Ephraim also is the strength of mine head; Judah is my lawgiver;
- **9** Moab *is* my washpot; over Edom will I cast out my shoe; over Philistia will I triumph.
- 10 Who will bring me into the strong city? who will lead me into Edom?
- 11 Wilt not thou, O God, who hast cast us off? and wilt not thou, O God, go forth with our hosts?
- **12** Give us help from trouble: for vain *is* the help of man.
- **13** Through God we shall do valiantly: for he *it is that* shall tread down our enemies.

To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David.

- **1** Hold not thy peace, O God of my praise;
- **2** For the mouth of the wicked and the mouth of the deceitful are opened against me: they have spoken against me with a lying tongue.
 - **3** They compassed me about also with words of hatred; and fought against me without a cause.
 - **4** For my love they are my adversaries: but I *give myself unto* prayer.
 - **5** And they have rewarded me evil for good, and hatred for my love.
 - **6** Set thou a wicked man over him: and let Satan stand at his right hand.
 - **7** When he shall be judged, let him be condemned: and let his prayer become sin.
 - 8 Let his days be few; and let another take his office.
 - **9** Let his children be fatherless, and his wife a widow.
 - 10 Let his children be continually vagabonds, and beg: let them seek their bread also out of their desolate places.
 - 11 Let the extortioner catch all that he hath; and let the strangers spoil his labour.
 - **12** Let there be none to extend mercy unto him: neither let there be any to favour his fatherless children.
 - 13 Let his posterity be cut off; and in the generation following let their name be blotted out.
 - 14 Let the iniquity of his fathers be remembered with the LORD; and let not the sin of his mother be blotted out.
 - **15** Let them be before the LORD continually, that he may cut off the memory of them from the earth.
- **16** Because that he remembered not to shew mercy, but persecuted the poor and needy man, that he might even slav the broken in heart.
 - 17 As he loved cursing, so let it come unto him: as he delighted not in blessing, so let it be far from him.
- 18 As he clothed himself with cursing like as with his garment, so let it come into his bowels like water, and like oil into his bones.
 - **19** Let it be unto him as the garment *which* covereth him, and for a girdle wherewith he is girdled continually.
 - **20** Let this be the reward of mine adversaries from the LORD, and of them that speak evil against my soul.
 - 21 But do thou for me, O GOD the Lord, for thy name's sake: because thy mercy is good, deliver thou me.
 - **22** For I *am* poor and needy, and my heart is wounded within me.
 - 23 I am gone like the shadow when it declineth: I am tossed up and down as the locust.
 - **24** My knees are weak through fasting; and my flesh faileth of fatness.
 - **25** I became also a reproach unto them: *when* they looked upon me they shaked their heads.
 - **26** Help me, O LORD my God: O save me according to thy mercy:
 - 27 That they may know that this is thy hand; that thou, LORD, hast done it.
 - 28 Let them curse, but bless thou: when they arise, let them be ashamed; but let thy servant rejoice.
- 29 Let mine adversaries be clothed with shame, and let them cover themselves with their own confusion, as with a mantle.
 - **30** I will greatly praise the LORD with my mouth; yea, I will praise him among the multitude.
 - **31** For he shall stand at the right hand of the poor, to save *him* from those that condemn his soul.

A Psalm of David.

- 1 The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.
- **2** The LORD shall send the rod of thy strength out of Zion: rule thou in the midst of thine enemies.
- **3** Thy people *shall be* willing in the day of thy power, in the beauties of holiness from the womb of the morning: thou hast the dew of thy youth.
- **4** The LORD hath sworn, and will not repent, Thou *art* a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek.
- **5** The Lord at thy right hand shall strike through kings in the day of his wrath.
- **6** He shall judge among the heathen, he shall fill *the places* with the dead bodies; he shall wound the heads over many countries.
 - **7** He shall drink of the brook in the way: therefore shall he lift up the head.

PSALM 111

- **1** Praise ye the LORD. I will praise the LORD with *my* whole heart, in the assembly of the upright, and *in* the congregation.
 - **2** The works of the LORD *are* great, sought out of all them that have pleasure therein.
 - **3** His work *is* honourable and glorious: and his righteousness endureth for ever.
 - **4** He hath made his wonderful works to be remembered: the LORD *is* gracious and full of compassion.
 - **5** He hath given meat unto them that fear him: he will ever be mindful of his covenant.
 - **6** He hath shewed his people the power of his works, that he may give them the heritage of the heathen.
 - **7** The works of his hands *are* verity and judgment; all his commandments *are* sure.
 - **8** They stand fast for ever and ever, and are done in truth and uprightness.
 - **9** He sent redemption unto his people: he hath commanded his covenant for ever: holy and reverend is his name.
- **10** The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do *his commandments*: his praise endureth for ever.

PSALM 112

- **1** Praise ye the LORD. Blessed *is* the man *that* feareth the LORD, *that* delighteth greatly in his commandments.
- **2** His seed shall be mighty upon earth: the generation of the upright shall be blessed.
- **3** Wealth and riches *shall be* in his house: and his righteousness endureth for ever.
- **4** Unto the upright there ariseth light in the darkness: *he is* gracious, and full of compassion, and righteous.
- **5** A good man sheweth favour, and lendeth: he will guide his affairs with discretion.
- **6** Surely he shall not be moved for ever: the righteous shall be in everlasting remembrance.
- **7** He shall not be afraid of evil tidings: his heart is fixed, trusting in the LORD.
- 8 His heart is established, he shall not be afraid, until he see his desire upon his enemies.
- **9** He hath dispersed, he hath given to the poor; his righteousness endureth for ever; his horn shall be exalted with honour.
- **10** The wicked shall see *it*, and be grieved; he shall gnash with his teeth, and melt away: the desire of the wicked shall perish.

- **1** Praise ye the LORD. Praise, O ye servants of the LORD, praise the name of the LORD.
- **2** Blessed be the name of the LORD from this time forth and for evermore.
- **3** From the rising of the sun unto the going down of the same the LORD'S name *is* to be praised.
- **4** The LORD *is* high above all nations, *and* his glory above the heavens.

- 5 Who is like unto the LORD our God, who dwelleth on high,
- **6** Who humbleth *himself* to behold *the things that are* in heaven, and in the earth!
- **7** He raiseth up the poor out of the dust, *and* lifteth the needy out of the dunghill;
- **8** That he may set *him* with princes, *even* with the princes of his people.
- 9 He maketh the barren woman to keep house, and to be a joyful mother of children. Praise ye the LORD.

- 1 When Israel went out of Egypt, the house of Jacob from a people of strange language;
- **2** Judah was his sanctuary, and Israel his dominion.
- **3** The sea saw *it*, and fled: Jordan was driven back.
- **4** The mountains skipped like rams, and the little hills like lambs.
- 5 What ailed thee, O thou sea, that thou fleddest? thou Jordan, that thou wast driven back?
- 6 Ye mountains, that ye skipped like rams; and ye little hills, like lambs?
- **7** Tremble, thou earth, at the presence of the Lord, at the presence of the God of Jacob;
- **8** Which turned the rock *into* a standing water, the flint into a fountain of waters.

PSALM 115

- 1 Not unto us, O LORD, not unto us, but unto thy name give glory, for thy mercy, and for thy truth's sake.
- 2 Wherefore should the heathen say, Where is now their God?
- **3** But our God *is* in the heavens; he hath done whatsoever he hath pleased.
- 4 Their idols are silver and gold, the work of men's hands.
- **5** They have mouths, but they speak not: eyes have they, but they see not:
- **6** They have ears, but they hear not: noses have they, but they smell not:
- **7** They have hands, but they handle not: feet have they, but they walk not: neither speak they through their throat.
 - **8** They that make them are like unto them; so is every one that trusteth in them.
 - **9** O Israel, trust thou in the LORD: he *is* their help and their shield.
 - **10** O house of Aaron, trust in the LORD: he *is* their help and their shield.
 - **11** Ye that fear the LORD, trust in the LORD: he *is* their help and their shield.
- 12 The LORD hath been mindful of us: he will bless us; he will bless the house of Israel; he will bless the house of Aaron.
 - **13** He will bless them that fear the LORD, *both* small and great.
 - **14** The LORD shall increase you more and more, you and your children.
 - 15 Ye are blessed of the LORD which made heaven and earth.
 - 16 The heaven, even the heavens, are the LORD'S: but the earth hath he given to the children of men.
 - 17 The dead praise not the LORD, neither any that go down into silence.
 - **18** But we will bless the LORD from this time forth and for evermore. Praise the LORD.

- **1** I love the LORD, because he hath heard my voice *and* my supplications.
- 2 Because he hath inclined his ear unto me, therefore will I call upon him as long as I live.
- **3** The sorrows of death compassed me, and the pains of hell gat hold upon me: I found trouble and sorrow.
- 4 Then called I upon the name of the LORD; O LORD, I beseech thee, deliver my soul.
- **5** Gracious *is* the LORD, and righteous; yea, our God *is* merciful.
- **6** The LORD preserveth the simple: I was brought low, and he helped me.
- 7 Return unto thy rest, O my soul; for the LORD hath dealt bountifully with thee.
- **8** For thou hast delivered my soul from death, mine eyes from tears, and my feet from falling.
- 9 I will walk before the LORD in the land of the living.

- **10** I believed, therefore have I spoken: I was greatly afflicted:
- **11** I said in my haste, All men *are* liars.
- 12 What shall I render unto the LORD for all his benefits toward me?
- **13** I will take the cup of salvation, and call upon the name of the LORD.
- **14** I will pay my vows unto the LORD now in the presence of all his people.
- **15** Precious in the sight of the LORD *is* the death of his saints.
- **16** O LORD, truly I am thy servant; I am thy servant, and the son of thine handmaid: thou hast loosed my bonds.
- **17** I will offer to thee the sacrifice of thanksgiving, and will call upon the name of the LORD.
- 18 I will pay my vows unto the LORD now in the presence of all his people,
- 19 In the courts of the LORD'S house, in the midst of thee, O Jerusalem. Praise ye the LORD.

- 1 O praise the LORD, all ye nations: praise him, all ye people.
- 2 For his merciful kindness is great toward us: and the truth of the LORD endureth for ever. Praise ye the LORD.

- **1** O give thanks unto the LORD; for *he is* good: because his mercy *endureth* for ever.
- **2** Let Israel now say, that his mercy *endureth* for ever.
- **3** Let the house of Aaron now say, that his mercy *endureth* for ever.
- **4** Let them now that fear the LORD say, that his mercy *endureth* for ever.
- **5** I called upon the LORD in distress: the LORD answered me, and set me in a large place.
- 6 The LORD is on my side; I will not fear: what can man do unto me?
- **7** The LORD taketh my part with them that help me: therefore shall I see my desire upon them that hate me.
- **8** It is better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in man.
- **9** It is better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in princes.
- **10** All nations compassed me about: but in the name of the LORD will I destroy them.
- **11** They compassed me about; yea, they compassed me about: but in the name of the LORD I will destroy them.
- 12 They compassed me about like bees; they are quenched as the fire of thorns: for in the name of the LORD I will destroy them.
 - **13** Thou hast thrust sore at me that I might fall: but the LORD helped me.
 - **14** The LORD *is* my strength and song, and is become my salvation.
- **15** The voice of rejoicing and salvation *is* in the tabernacles of the righteous: the right hand of the LORD doeth valiantly.
 - **16** The right hand of the LORD is exalted: the right hand of the LORD doeth valiantly.
 - 17 I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the LORD.
 - **18** The LORD hath chastened me sore: but he hath not given me over unto death.
 - **19** Open to me the gates of righteousness: I will go into them, *and* I will praise the LORD:
 - 20 This gate of the LORD, into which the righteous shall enter.
 - **21** I will praise thee: for thou hast heard me, and art become my salvation.
 - **22** The stone *which* the builders refused is become the head *stone* of the corner.
 - 23 This is the LORD'S doing; it is marvellous in our eyes.
 - **24** This *is* the day *which* the LORD hath made; we will rejoice and be glad in it.
 - **25** Save now, I beseech thee, O LORD: O LORD, I beseech thee, send now prosperity.
 - **26** Blessed *be* he that cometh in the name of the LORD: we have blessed you out of the house of the LORD.
- **27** God *is* the LORD, which hath shewed us light: bind the sacrifice with cords, *even* unto the horns of the altar.
- 28 Thou art my God, and I will praise thee: thou art my God, I will exalt thee.
- **29** O give thanks unto the LORD; for *he is* good: for his mercy *endureth* for ever.

Aleph

- Blessed *are* the undefiled in the way, who walk in the law of the LORD.
- 2 Blessed are they that keep his testimonies, and that seek him with the whole heart.
- They also do no iniquity: they walk in his ways.
- Thou hast commanded *us* to keep thy precepts diligently.
- O that my ways were directed to keep thy statutes!
- Then shall I not be ashamed, when I have respect unto all thy commandments.
- I will praise thee with uprightness of heart, when I shall have learned thy righteous judgments.
- 8 I will keep thy statutes: O forsake me not utterly.

Beth

- Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by taking heed *thereto* according to thy word.
- With my whole heart have I sought thee: O let me not wander from thy commandments.
- Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.
- 12 Blessed art thou, O LORD: teach me thy statutes.
- With my lips have I declared all the judgments of thy mouth.
- I have rejoiced in the way of thy testimonies, as *much as* in all riches.
- I will meditate in thy precepts, and have respect unto thy ways.
- I will delight myself in thy statutes: I will not forget thy word.

- Deal bountifully with thy servant, *that* I may live, and keep thy word.

- 45 And I will walk at liberty: for I seek thy precepts.
- I will speak of thy testimonies also before kings, and will not be ashamed.
- And I will delight myself in thy commandments, which I have loved.
- 48 My hands also will I lift up unto thy commandments, which I have loved; and I will meditate in thy statutes.

- I am thine, save me; for I have sought thy precepts.

- I have seen an end of all perfection: *but* thy commandment *is* exceeding broad.

- O how love I thy law! it *is* my meditation all the day.
- 98 Thou through thy commandments hast made me wiser than mine enemies: for they are ever with me.

- **100** I understand more than the ancients, because I keep thy precepts.

- Thy word *is* a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.
- I have sworn, and I will perform it, that I will keep thy righteous judgments.
- I am afflicted very much: quicken me, O LORD, according unto thy word.
- Accept, I beseech thee, the freewill offerings of my mouth, O LORD, and teach me thy judgments.
- My soul *is* continually in my hand: yet do I not forget thy law.
- The wicked have laid a snare for me: yet I erred not from thy precepts.
- Thy testimonies have I taken as an heritage for ever: for they *are* the rejoicing of my heart.
- I have inclined mine heart to perform thy statutes alway, even unto the end.

 - 6 Though the LORD be high, yet hath he respect unto the lowly: but the proud he knoweth afar off.

- For *there is* not a word in my tongue, *but*, lo, O LORD, thou knowest it altogether.
- Thou hast beset me behind and before, and laid thine hand upon me.
- Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; it is high, I cannot attain unto it.
- Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence?
- 8 If I ascend up into heaven, thou art there: if I make my bed in hell, behold, thou art there.
- If I take the wings of the morning, and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea;

 - **13** For thou hast possessed my reins: thou hast covered me in my mother's womb.
- **14** I will praise thee; for I am fearfully *and* wonderfully made: marvellous *are* thy works; and *that* my soul knoweth right well.
- **15** My substance was not hid from thee, when I was made in secret, *and* curiously wrought in the lowest parts of the earth.
- **16** Thine eyes did see my substance, yet being unperfect; and in thy book all *my members* were written, *which* in continuance were fashioned, when *as yet there was* none of them.
 - **17** How precious also are thy thoughts unto me, O God! how great is the sum of them!
 - 18 If I should count them, they are more in number than the sand: when I awake, I am still with thee.
 - **19** Surely thou wilt slay the wicked, O God: depart from me therefore, ye bloody men.
 - **20** For they speak against thee wickedly, *and* thine enemies take *thy name* in vain.
 - 21 Do not I hate them, O LORD, that hate thee? and am not I grieved with those that rise up against thee?
 - **22** I hate them with perfect hatred: I count them mine enemies.
 - 23 Search me, O God, and know my heart: try me, and know my thoughts:
 - **24** And see if *there be any* wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.

- 1 Deliver me, O LORD, from the evil man: preserve me from the violent man;
- **2** Which imagine mischiefs in *their* heart; continually are they gathered together *for* war.

- **4** Incline not my heart to *any* evil thing, to practise wicked works with men that work iniquity: and let me not eat of their dainties.

Maschil of David; A Prayer when he was in the cave.

- **1** I cried unto the LORD with my voice; with my voice unto the LORD did I make my supplication.
- **2** I poured out my complaint before him; I shewed before him my trouble.
- **3** When my spirit was overwhelmed within me, then thou knewest my path. In the way wherein I walked have they privily laid a snare for me.
- **4** I looked on *my* right hand, and beheld, but *there was* no man that would know me: refuge failed me; no man cared for my soul.
 - **5** I cried unto thee, O LORD: I said, Thou art my refuge and my portion in the land of the living.
 - 6 Attend unto my cry; for I am brought very low: deliver me from my persecutors; for they are stronger than I.
- **7** Bring my soul out of prison, that I may praise thy name: the righteous shall compass me about; for thou shalt deal bountifully with me.

PSALM 143

A Psalm of David.

- **1** Hear my prayer, O LORD, give ear to my supplications: in thy faithfulness answer me, *and* in thy righteousness.
- 2 And enter not into judgment with thy servant: for in thy sight shall no man living be justified.
- **3** For the enemy hath persecuted my soul; he hath smitten my life down to the ground; he hath made me to dwell in darkness, as those that have been long dead.
 - **4** Therefore is my spirit overwhelmed within me; my heart within me is desolate.
 - **5** I remember the days of old; I meditate on all thy works; I muse on the work of thy hands.
 - **6** I stretch forth my hands unto thee: my soul *thirsteth* after thee, as a thirsty land. Selah.
- **7** Hear me speedily, O LORD: my spirit faileth: hide not thy face from me, lest I be like unto them that go down into the pit.
- **8** Cause me to hear thy lovingkindness in the morning; for in thee do I trust: cause me to know the way wherein I should walk; for I lift up my soul unto thee.
 - **9** Deliver me, O LORD, from mine enemies: I flee unto thee to hide me.
 - **10** Teach me to do thy will; for thou *art* my God: thy spirit *is* good; lead me into the land of uprightness.
 - 11 Quicken me, O LORD, for thy name's sake: for thy righteousness' sake bring my soul out of trouble.
 - 12 And of thy mercy cut off mine enemies, and destroy all them that afflict my soul: for I am thy servant.

PSALM 144

A Psalm of David.

- **1** Blessed *be* the LORD my strength, which teacheth my hands to war, *and* my fingers to fight:
- **2** My goodness, and my fortress; my high tower, and my deliverer; my shield, and *he* in whom I trust; who subdueth my people under me.
- **3** LORD, what is man, that thou takest knowledge of him! or the son of man, that thou makest account of him!
- **4** Man is like to vanity: his days *are* as a shadow that passeth away.
- **5** Bow thy heavens, O LORD, and come down: touch the mountains, and they shall smoke.
- **6** Cast forth lightning, and scatter them: shoot out thine arrows, and destroy them.
- **7** Send thine hand from above; rid me, and deliver me out of great waters, from the hand of strange children;
- **8** Whose mouth speaketh vanity, and their right hand is a right hand of falsehood.
- 9 I will sing a new song unto thee, O God: upon a psaltery and an instrument of ten strings will I sing praises unto

thee.

- 10 It is he that giveth salvation unto kings: who delivereth David his servant from the hurtful sword.
- **11** Rid me, and deliver me from the hand of strange children, whose mouth speaketh vanity, and their right hand *is* a right hand of falsehood:
- **12** That our sons *may be* as plants grown up in their youth; *that* our daughters *may be* as corner stones, polished *after* the similitude of a palace:
- **13** That our garners may be full, affording all manner of store: that our sheep may bring forth thousands and ten thousands in our streets:
- **14** That our oxen may be strong to labour; that there be no breaking in, nor going out; that there be no complaining in our streets.
 - 15 Happy is that people, that is in such a case: yea, happy is that people, whose God is the LORD.

PSALM 145

David's *Psalm* of praise.

- **1** I will extol thee, my God, O king; and I will bless thy name for ever and ever.
- **2** Every day will I bless thee; and I will praise thy name for ever and ever.
- **3** Great *is* the LORD, and greatly to be praised; and his greatness *is* unsearchable.
- **4** One generation shall praise thy works to another, and shall declare thy mighty acts.
- **5** I will speak of the glorious honour of thy majesty, and of thy wondrous works.
- **6** And *men* shall speak of the might of thy terrible acts: and I will declare thy greatness.
- **7** They shall abundantly utter the memory of thy great goodness, and shall sing of thy righteousness.
- **8** The LORD *is* gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy.
- **9** The LORD *is* good to all: and his tender mercies *are* over all his works.
- 10 All thy works shall praise thee, O LORD; and thy saints shall bless thee.
- 11 They shall speak of the glory of thy kingdom, and talk of thy power;
- 12 To make known to the sons of men his mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of his kingdom.
- **13** Thy kingdom *is* an everlasting kingdom, and thy dominion *endureth* throughout all generations.
- **14** The LORD upholdeth all that fall, and raiseth up all *those that be* bowed down.
- **15** The eyes of all wait upon thee; and thou givest them their meat in due season.
- **16** Thou openest thine hand, and satisfiest the desire of every living thing.
- **17** The LORD *is* righteous in all his ways, and holy in all his works.
- **18** The LORD *is* nigh unto all them that call upon him, to all that call upon him in truth.
- 19 He will fulfil the desire of them that fear him: he also will hear their cry, and will save them.
- **20** The LORD preserveth all them that love him: but all the wicked will he destroy.
- 21 My mouth shall speak the praise of the LORD: and let all flesh bless his holy name for ever and ever.

- 1 Praise ye the LORD. Praise the LORD, O my soul.
- **2** While I live will I praise the LORD: I will sing praises unto my God while I have any being.
- **3** Put not your trust in princes, *nor* in the son of man, in whom *there is* no help.
- **4** His breath goeth forth, he returneth to his earth; in that very day his thoughts perish.
- **5** Happy *is he* that *hath* the God of Jacob for his help, whose hope *is* in the LORD his God:
- **6** Which made heaven, and earth, the sea, and all that therein *is*: which keepeth truth for ever:
- **7** Which executeth judgment for the oppressed: which giveth food to the hungry. The LORD looseth the prisoners:
- **8** The LORD openeth *the eyes of* the blind: the LORD raiseth them that are bowed down: the LORD loveth the righteous:
- **9** The LORD preserveth the strangers; he relieveth the fatherless and widow: but the way of the wicked he turneth upside down.
 - 10 The LORD shall reign for ever, even thy God, O Zion, unto all generations. Praise ye the LORD.

- Praise ye the LORD: for *it is* good to sing praises unto our God; for *it is* pleasant; *and* praise is comely.
- 2 The LORD doth build up Jerusalem: he gathereth together the outcasts of Israel.
- He healeth the broken in heart, and bindeth up their wounds.
- He telleth the number of the stars; he calleth them all by *their* names.
- Great *is* our Lord, and of great power: his understanding *is* infinite.
- The LORD lifteth up the meek: he casteth the wicked down to the ground.
- Sing unto the LORD with thanksgiving; sing praise upon the harp unto our God:
- Who covereth the heaven with clouds, who prepareth rain for the earth, who maketh grass to grow upon the mountains.
 - He giveth to the beast his food, *and* to the young ravens which cry.
 - **10** He delighteth not in the strength of the horse: he taketh not pleasure in the legs of a man.
- **11** The LORD taketh pleasure in them that fear him, in those that hope in his mercy.
- Praise the LORD, O Jerusalem; praise thy God, O Zion.
- **13** For he hath strengthened the bars of thy gates; he hath blessed thy children within thee.
- He maketh peace *in* thy borders, *and* filleth thee with the finest of the wheat.
- He sendeth forth his commandment *upon* earth: his word runneth very swiftly.
- He giveth snow like wool: he scattereth the hoarfrost like ashes.
- 17 He casteth forth his ice like morsels: who can stand before his cold?
- He sendeth out his word, and melteth them: he causeth his wind to blow, and the waters flow.
- He sheweth his word unto Jacob, his statutes and his judgments unto Israel.
- 20 He hath not dealt so with any nation: and as for his judgments, they have not known them. Praise ye the LORD.

PSALM 148

- Praise ye the LORD. Praise ye the LORD from the heavens: praise him in the heights.
- 2 Praise ye him, all his angels: praise ye him, all his hosts.
- Praise ye him, sun and moon: praise him, all ye stars of light.
- Praise him, ye heavens of heavens, and ye waters that *be* above the heavens.
- Let them praise the name of the LORD: for he commanded, and they were created.
- 6 He hath also stablished them for ever and ever: he hath made a decree which shall not pass.
- Praise the LORD from the earth, ye dragons, and all deeps:
- Fire, and hail; snow, and vapour; stormy wind fulfilling his word:
- 9 Mountains, and all hills; fruitful trees, and all cedars:
- Beasts, and all cattle; creeping things, and flying fowl:
- Kings of the earth, and all people; princes, and all judges of the earth:
- Both young men, and maidens; old men, and children:
- **13** Let them praise the name of the LORD: for his name alone is excellent; his glory is above the earth and heaven.
- He also exalteth the horn of his people, the praise of all his saints; *even* of the children of Israel, a people near unto him. Praise ye the LORD.

- Praise ye the LORD. Sing unto the LORD a new song, *and* his praise in the congregation of saints.
- Let Israel rejoice in him that made him: let the children of Zion be joyful in their King.
- Let them praise his name in the dance: let them sing praises unto him with the timbrel and harp.
- **4** For the LORD taketh pleasure in his people: he will beautify the meek with salvation.
- Let the saints be joyful in glory: let them sing aloud upon their beds.
- **6** Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a two-edged sword in their hand;
- To execute vengeance upon the heathen, *and* punishments upon the people;
- To bind their kings with chains, and their nobles with fetters of iron;

9 To execute upon them the judgment written: this honour have all his saints. Praise ye the LORD.

- Praise ye the LORD. Praise God in his sanctuary: praise him in the firmament of his power.
- Praise him for his mighty acts: praise him according to his excellent greatness.
- **3** Praise him with the sound of the trumpet: praise him with the psaltery and harp.
- Praise him with the timbrel and dance: praise him with stringed instruments and organs.
- Praise him upon the loud cymbals: praise him upon the high sounding cymbals.
- Let every thing that hath breath praise the LORD. Praise ye the LORD.
